Public Services, Education and Utilities

The Village of Williamsburg is proud to be the home of the Williamsburg Wildcats. The Williamsburg Local School district continues to build upon its academic excellence through programming at the Middle/High School campus, with the elementary school a short walk away. The Genesis Center, a regional alternative school, is housed at the districts third site. Williamsburg is part of the highly rated U.S. Grant Joint Vocational District and the University of Cincinnati's Clermont College is a short 10-minute drive from the village.

The Village of Williamsburg is served by our own Police Department, which offers twenty-four hour a day patrol and service to the Village. Fire and EMS services are provided by Williamsburg Township Emergency Services, located within the Village of Williamsburg.

Street maintenance, water, sewer, trash collection, recycling options, digital cable television, high speed internet and extensive cellular coverage are just a few of the service options available to Village residents or businesses.



Community Strengths and Amenities

The Village of Williamsburg maintains a thirty-five (35) acre park facility, located at 150 East Main Street. Twelve (12) acres of this park are developed and offer a variety of amenities including a playground (new in 2006), basketball court, shelter, restroom facilities, a disc golf course, a baseball field, a walking trail, picnic tables and river access.



Clermont County offers a wealth of recreational activities. East Fork State Park is located just minutes to the southwest of the Village. This park offers several public boat ramps accessing Harsha Lake along with a public beach, trails, a rowing facility that hosts many regional and national events and is home to the one of the largest type-A campgrounds in the state of Ohio. The Village of Williamsburg is connected to East Fork State Park by way of the Williamsburg-Batavia Hike/Bike Trail. Once completed, this trail will ultimately connect the Village of Williamsburg to the Village of Batavia.

The Village of Williamsburg is rich with history... boasting the oldest structure in the County – Major General William Lytle's Dairy House. Further the Village is the site of several Underground Railroad locations and many other historical points of interest.



The Village is home to over sixty local businesses. Williamsburg is pleased to be the corporate headquarters of Dualite Inc. and Croswell Motorcoach Charter and Tours. You will find antique stores, gift/floral shops, restaurants, professional services, grocery and convenience stores along with a full service pharmacy, automotive maintenance and repair and gas stations to mention just a few within the village limits. If you can't find everything you need inside the Village, Williamsburg is located just 13 miles east of I-275, which provides quick access to the attractions of downtown Cincinnati. River Bend at Coney Island, Paramount Kings Island, the Newport Aquarium, the Cincinnati Zoo, Cincinnati Reds and Bengals stadiums are just a few of these attractions. The Greater Cincinnati Airport, Cincinnati shopping and restaurants are well within reach of downtown Williamsburg.
