

AN ORDINANCE BY THE VILLAGE OF WILLIAMSBURG
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 921-04 ZONING CODE

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Williamsburg wishes to amend the Village Of Williamsburg Zoning Code Ordinance No. 921-04 Article IV: Supplementary Provisions as follows:

Section 4.28 – OTHER ANIMAL PROHIBITIONS

- (a) No person shall own, keep or harbor live cattle, sheep, geese, ducks, turkeys, chickens, pigs, goats or other farm-type animals within the municipal limits of the Village of Williamsburg, Ohio. This subsection shall not apply to the following:
- (1) Animals which are located on premises which are five acres or more in size under the same contiguous ownership and are located on such premises with the consent of the property owners.
 - (2) Animals which are located on the premises of a public or non-public school which is chartered by the State of Ohio Department of Education and such animals are used in the instruction of students.
 - (3) Animals which are caged and or confined during actual transport by vehicle in the Village.
 - (4) Equine animals as addressed in Section 4.22 of the Village of Williamsburg Zoning Code, Ordinance No. 921-04.
- (b) Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor for the first offense and a misdemeanor of the fourth degree for each subsequent offense.

This Ordinance is deemed emergency for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Williamsburg and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
